

GVWG Service Award – Terms of Reference

The purpose of the award is to publicly recognize individuals that contribute to the Guild in meaningful ways. Examples of such contributions may be:

- Organizing a major event for the Guild;
- Performing duties for the Guild regularly, consistently and well;
- Representing the Guild to the public to the benefit of both the Guild and the public

Nomination Process

Any member in good standing may be nominated for this award. Nomination forms must be signed by at least three members-in-good-standing and then forwarded to the Secretary for consideration by the current sitting Board.

Evaluation Process

The Board will consider each nomination and deliver an answer to the nominators in a timely manner. To be approved, 80% of the votes cast must be in favour of the nomination. The following criteria will be used:

- The contribution must be meaningful to the Guild and/or its members;
- Long service may be considered an appropriate contribution;
- Current Board service should not be considered for this award.

Presentation Ceremony

The Board will appoint a member to deliver the commendation and award at a regular Guild meeting. The commendation should include (but not be limited to) the reasons given in the nomination form.
